Season Pass Cancellation & Interruption: Season Pass Price Paid: Covers the cost of your season pass if you are no longer able to use the pass for reasons such as sickness or injury to you, a family member, or traveling companion; primary residence or destination being made uninhabitable, being subpoenaed, required to serve on jury duty, or quarantined; job transfer; pregnancy or childbirth; employer termination or layoff.

24-Hour Assistance

24-Hour Emergency Hotline: Immediate help with any travel or medical emergency when you need it, wherever you need it; includes cash advances, telephone interpretation, passport or ticket replacement, physician referrals and appointments, prescription replacement, lost or delayed baggage tracing and delivery assistance, and roadside assistance.

Pre-Existing Medical Condition Exclusion Waiver: If insurance is purchased within 14 days of purchase of the ski pass, the Pre-Existing Medical Condition Exclusion will be waived. You must be medically able to travel when you pay your plan cost.
